<b>Defining Success</b>	<b>OBJECTIVE:</b> What will your students be able to do by the end of class?	
	<b>ASSESSMENT:</b> How will you know concretely that all of your students have mastered the objective?	<b>KEY POINTS:</b> What three to five main ideas or steps will you emphasize in your lesson? May also include key questions to ask during instruction.

<b>Lesson Cycle</b>	<b>ELICIT:</b> Access prior knowledge.	<b>MATERIALS</b>
	<b>ENGAGE:</b> Get the students' minds focused on the topic (short; question or picture).	
	<b>EXPLORE:</b> Provide students with a common experience.	
	<b>EXPLAIN:</b> Teach the concept. Should include interaction between teacher and students.	
<b>ELABORATE:</b> Students apply the information learned in the Explain.		

	<b>EVALUATE: How will you know the students have learned the concept?</b>	
	<b>EXTEND: Deepen conceptual understanding through use in new context.</b>
